- Additional opportunities include: National Junior Honor Society, Academic Olympics, Science Fair, Young Authors program, educational/cultural field trips, and community service projects

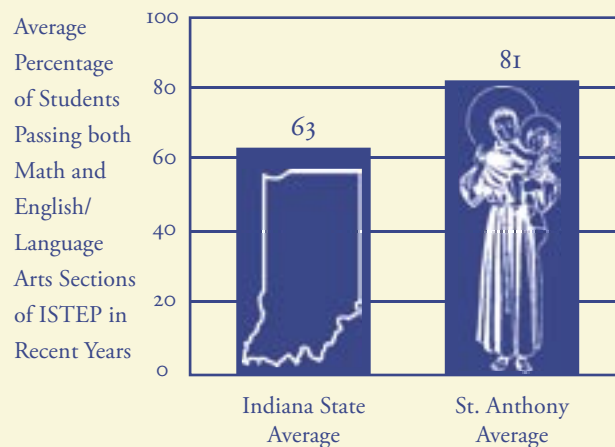
Mission
